

### Oregon ash

*Scientific:* Fraxinus latifolia Benth.

*Primary category:* Tree

*Habitat:* Forests, Wetlands

*Description (by Bosky Dell Natives):*

Deciduous, broadleaved tree (40-80 ft.) with pinnately compound leaves. Yellow fall color! Fast growth rate. Oregon ash usually grows in moist areas at low elevations (sea level to 2500 ft.).

Sun/part sun, regular water.
